

ASSIGNMENT OF RIGHTS FOR REPAYMENT

We have conducted an audit of all residents who have a Life Plan contract to ensure that there is a beneficiary in place should a refund be due when the resident is no longer with Westminster. The Assignment of benefits will allow the resident to assign his/her interest in any refund, under the residency agreement, to an assignee/assignees, estate, trust, etc. Once the audit is completed, either Callie Spudes or Colleen Matthews will reach out to residents who do not have a completed beneficiary/assignment of rights document. If you are not contacted by September 5, no follow-up is needed.
