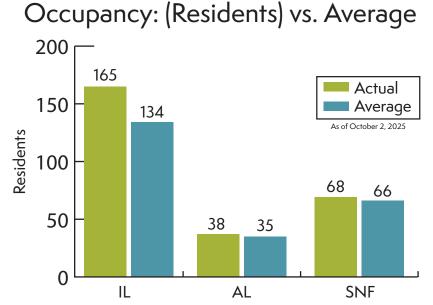
As always, I am grateful for the energy and warmth you bring to this community. Your participation and feedback help shape Westminster Village into the vibrant, thriving place it is today.

Capital Investment in Boilers and Chillers

We're excited to share that Westminster Village has signed a contract with Sycamore to upgrade two boilers and two main chillers in the main building. As part of this project, we'll also be replacing three chillers in the Health Center. These upgrades mark an important step toward greater energy efficiency, system reliability, and year-round comfort for everyone in our community.

The new, modern systems will help lower energy costs, reduce our environmental impact, and ensure consistent heating and cooling. In addition, all equipment will be connected to our building management system, allowing us to identify and address minor issues before they become larger concerns.

This investment demonstrates our continued commitment to creating a comfortable, efficient, and sustainable environment for residents, while also adding long-term value to our community.

INDEPENDENT LIVING VACCINE CLINIC

Mark your calendars for the Independent Living Vaccine Clinic on October 17 from 11:00 AM to 2:00 PM in the Card Room on the 1st floor. To receive a vaccine, pre-registration is required. You can register on paper with Samantha Wray by October 8, or complete the online/electronic registration by October 13. Residents received two consent forms in their mailboxes: one for COVID and flu (combined) and one for RSV. The COVID/flu form can be completed either on paper or online, while the RSV form must be completed on paper. If you have any questions, contact Samantha Wray at extension 5413. Vaccines for SNF and AL residents will be available from November 5–7, provided by Guardian.
